

Thank you for agreeing to host a local church hall/ fire hall/ social club showing in your town. Enclosed please find detailed instructions on how to make your event a success.

Step 1: Pray. *"But seek first His kingdom and His righteousness, and all these things will be added to you. Matthew 6:33"*

The most important thing to remember is that we are merely the paperboy delivering the message to God's people. We must first, foremost and continually do this through Him, In Him and with Him, and at no time let our own pride get in the way. This process is probably the quickest and easiest way to get the film shown. Many halls have audio/visual set-ups already in place and it's as easy as walking in with a DVD and hitting play. If they do not call RSP for ideas on how to acquire the equipment you would need to make your event a success. If you have to rent production equipment obviously there would be an additional cost. Simply call your club/social hall steward and ask! Please revisit step 1.

Step 2: Contact a local Pro-Life group in your area. Find a group that is active in your community. Ask them to send emails out to their mailing lists and make phone calls to get people to the event. See step 1.

Step 3: Band together with other churches/clubs/and groups in your area that will generously give to this cause. Using one church as a host but having a multitude of churches marketing makes sense. See step 1.

Step 4: Enjoy the show!

Step 5: Speak to the crowd after the film. Use this teachable moment to reach those who may be ready to accept Christ. Also it's a great time to explain what your organization does for the Pro-Life movement and take a collection to support future theater events for this film. Then see step 1 again!

May the Peace and Joy of our Lord Jesus Christ be upon you and your organization as together we embark on a journey to change hearts, minds and save souls for the Kingdom of God.
